Looking for things to do in Denmark? Learn about Danish history at the Moesgaard Museum in Aarhus.



Aarhus's new, dedicated centre for archaeology and ethnography, the **Moesgaard Museum**, offers a fresh perspective on Danish history.

Spanning the Stone Age to the Middle Ages, it houses some of **Denmark**'s most important artefacts including the amazingly preserved prehistoric figure known as the 'Grauballe Man' and a fascinating Viking exhibition.

Designed to embody the form of a natural mound, with white stone lines and a grass roof, the striking museum will be equally innovative inside, mixing state-of-the-art technology with fascinating backdrops and dramatised storytelling. Set in South Aarhus, surrounded by tranquil woods with sweeping views out **to the sea**, the museum grounds are delightful.
